**Subject: Renewal of Undergraduate Seats (MBBS) of  
Rajarajeswari Medical College & Hospital, Bangalore, for the  
year AY- 2025-26 - regarding.**

**Sir/Madam,**

I am directed to refer to the Public Notice issued by UGMEB vide dated 01.11.2024 uploaded on the NMC website on 06.11.2024, directing all medical colleges with valid Letters of Permission (LoP) to upload the details/data of their respective institutions on the NMC portal for the annual declaration, as required under the NMC Act, 2019 and various regulations issued by NMC from time to time, for the grant of renewal of MBBS seats for the academic year 2025-26.

2. Based on the details furnished by your college, the experts assessed the submissions, and accordingly, a Notice dated **12.05.2025** was issued highlighting the following deficiencies observed during the assessment:

- i. Fourteen (14) out of Twenty (20) departments are deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data.
- ii. PDF of LOP not attached.
- iii. PDF of increase of seats not attached.
- iv. One (01) out of Twenty (20) departments is deficient as per self declaration form for Faculty/SR.
- v. Examination video not uploaded.

3. Subsequently, the compliance report submitted by your

Institution was also evaluated by the Assessors; however, amongst other deficiencies, following key deficiencies were again highlighted w.r.t. your College/Institution:

- i. Some departments are still deficient in faculty/Resident/tutor as per AEBAS record data, however your explanation has been accepted therefore, the college may adhere to the deficiencies found in the AEBAS.

Further, it has been observed that during the renewal process for the previous year AY 2024-25, penalty was imposed and conditional renewal was granted in view of the substantive nature of deficiencies in your College.

4. The Competent Authority has reviewed the Annual Declaration Report (ADR) submitted by your college/institutions and also the deficiencies pointed out by the experts. The compliance report submitted by the college has not been found to be convincing and satisfactory.

5. However, UGMEB has taken a lenient view and **decided to grant conditional renewal of 250 UG (MBBS) seats** for the academic year 2025-26, **subject to rectification of deficiencies within four months from the issuance of this letter.**

6. A further review will be conducted after four months, and if the deficiencies are found to persist at that time, stringent action will be initiated as mandated under Chapter III, Clause 8 of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations (MSMER), 2023, and any other applicable rules or regulations.

7. If the College/Institution is not satisfied and aggrieved with the decision of the Board, you may prefer an appeal before the Commission under Section 9, Chapter IV of the Maintenance of Standards of Medical Education Regulations, 2023, (MSMER, 2023) within Sixty (60) days of the issue of this letter.

2. It is to inform you that your institution is fully responsible to fulfill and maintain norms including the infrastructure both physical and human resource, teaching faculty,

clinical material and stipend to PG students similar to PG students of government colleges in the state etc. throughout the academic year, as stipulated in regulation of National Medical Commission (NMC).

3. In case of false/wrong declaration or fabricated documents have been used for procuring permissions of MARB and any misconduct is brought to the notice of National Medical Commission (NMC) or found during surprise assessment at any stage during the current academic year, your institution is liable, not to be considered for recognition of that degree. This letter of permission will be revoked for the current academic year if such exigency arises.

4. Besides, National Medical Commission (NMC) is entitled to take all such measure against you and your college/institution as permissible under the law.

5. It is mandatory by government medical colleges to contribute 15% MBBS seats and 50% of post graduate broad specialties (MD/MS) for All India Quota respectively, to MCC of DGHS for conduction of counseling as per the directions of hon'ble Supreme Court.

6. It is mandatory to develop a website of medical college/institution and display all the information of college, courses offered faculty available and their experience of last 5 years, students joined, and affiliating university to display the hospital services, facilities available and the equipment in each specialty, also showing OP and IP census including births and deaths as per the Municipal/Government records.

7. In case college does not agree with the above decision of MARB, it may prefer an appeal under section 28 (5) of NMC Act, 2019 addressed to Secretary NMC within 15 days of this order, though online mode only as per NMC's Public notices dated 21.05.2024 and 30.05.2024.
