Day 1- The first session was led by Ms. M. Pavithra, PGT at Daniel Thomas Matric Hr. Sec. School. She encouraged the students to prepare for the TET competitive exam, emphasizing its role in developing critical skills such as conceptual understanding and practical application. She focused on essential time management techniques, daily study planning, and effective methods for covering each section of the syllabus. She also demonstrated practical problem-solving examples, helping students to approach and solve questions with greater efficiency and confidence.

Day 2 - Ms. B. Monisha, Assistant Professor, Department of Computer Science, R.B.G. Jain College for Women, led an insightful session. She provided valuable guidance on active revision techniques, recommending the use of flashcards, summarizing key points, and engaging in group discussions—all aimed at enhancing concept retention, understanding, and recall. CTET is Central Teacher Eligibility

CTET is Central Qualification for the posts in the rights for appointment as regular Government Teachers in Government Schools for Class I to Class V.

CTET is conducted by CBSE (Central Board of Secondary Education) in accordance with the guidelines provided by NCTE. Exams are held for 12 months.

CTET has been held in year 2021. CTET Exam is conducted after 2021 results.
