Awareness Rally

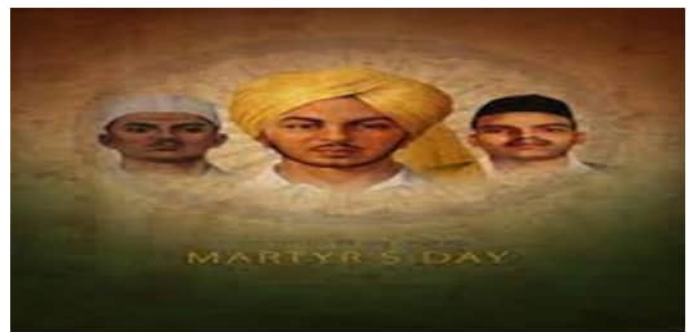
