Kishore Kumar, MPT(Hand), Ph.D. M.D(Acu), MIAP, Senior Physiotherapist, Director-Manuszeal Healthcare Academy & KK Physio and Hand Therapy Centre, Chennai was done by Dr. P. AnuPreethi, Assistant Professor, Faculty of Physiotherapy. The Speaker started the First Session by explaining the functions, injuries, causes, indications, assessment and rehabilitation of hand. Mr. Anil Kumar, D.PO, Director-Clinical Services, South Zone, Ottobock Healthcare India Pvt Ltd. Speaker presented the video on Pre-Prosthetic Management, Parts of Myoelectric Prostheses and its connections, working methods and EMG study using Myoelectric Prostheses on 07/07/23.


